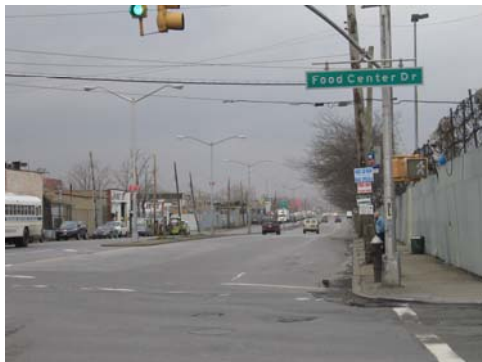

The South Bronx Greenway encompasses much of the Hunts Point peninsula in the South Bronx. This project is providing street and open space improvements including a new roadway and shoreline improvements, traffic signals, signage, custom signage, site furniture, landscaping and other related improvements.

The project includes the creation of new Hunts Point shoreline amenities including waterfront esplanades, fishing piers and kayak launches.

A key part of the project is the replacement of 3,000 feet of the dilapidated sheet metal Produce Market fence with a new concrete panel fence system, considered critical to the revitalization of the area. This project has evolved with EDC and two community groups, Sustainable South Bronx and THE POINT Community Development Corporation. The Greenway will include pedestrian and bicycle paths along the South Bronx Waterfront and streets leading to the shoreline.

The Hunts Point Market distributes produce, meat and fish to over 22 million consumers within a fifty mile radius of the market. Market security is a key concern of the project, and the security fence will be carefully staged to ensure a safe perimeter.

Hirani's role in this project includes daily construction inspection and a lead role in community relations, working with the businesses and non profit organizations to advance the project goals.
